

Panhellenic Association Financial Outline

Panhellenic Association Dues:

At the beginning of the spring semester, the Panhellenic Council passes a Panhellenic Association General Budget and Panhellenic Association Recruitment Budget. This budget indicates where money collected through Panhellenic Association dues will be spent. Panhellenic Association dues are mutually determined by considering the financial needs of the Panhellenic Council, as well as considering the cost to member chapters. The discrepancy in dues between the NPC chapters and Associate chapters takes into consideration the costs associated with Formal Membership Recruitment. The Panhellenic Council is required to keep the Panhellenic Association dues below \$30.00 per semester per member.

New Member Recruitment Fee:

All new members joining NPC Chapters pay a \$20.00 New Member Recruitment Fee in their first semester of membership. This fee assists in covering the cost of Fall Formal Membership Recruitment and Spring COB Recruitment, helping to keep the cost of signing up and going through the formal membership recruitment process at a minimum.

Tentative Spring Semester Billing Schedule:

(rosters are updated through OFSL according to elevation)

2 nd week of Spring semester:	All chapters must update their chapter roster for current Members (through Elevation requirements)
3 rd week of Spring semester:	Panhellenic Association general budget is introduced at Panhellenic Council meeting.
4 th week of Spring semester:	Recruitment budget is introduced at Panhellenic Council meeting and Panhellenic Council votes on general budget.
5 th week Spring semester:	Recruitment budget is voted on at Panhellenic Council meeting
6 th week of Spring semester:	Chapters given invoice for active member dues (includes PHA dues)
8 th Week of Spring semester:	All chapters must submit checks for active member dues to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life by invoice due date (Chapters not submitting payment will be fined 10% of the invoiced amount)
8 th week of Spring semester:	All chapters must update their chapter roster for current members (through Elevation requirements)
10 th week of Spring semester:	Chapters given invoice for new member dues (includes Panhellenic Association dues and new member recruitment fee)
11 th week of Spring semester:	All chapters must submit checks for new member dues to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life by invoice due date (chapters not submitting payment will be fined 10% of the invoiced amount)

Tentative Fall Semester Billing Schedule:

1 st week of Fall semester:	All chapters must update their chapter roster for current members (through Elevation requirements)
2 nd week of Fall semester:	Chapters given invoice for active member dues (includes Panhellenic Association Dues)
4 th week of Fall semester:	All chapters must submit checks for active member dues to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life by invoice due date (chapters not submitting payment will be fined 10% of the invoiced amount)
7 th week of Fall Semester:	All chapters must update their chapter roster for current members (through Elevation requirements)
8 th week of Fall Semester:	Chapters given invoice for new member dues (includes Panhellenic Association dues and new Member Recruitment Fee)
9 th week of Fall Semester:	All chapters must submit checks for new member dues to the Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life by invoice due date (chapters not submitting payment will be fined 10% of the invoiced amount)
