ELIGIBILITY TO RUN

You must meet all of the following requirements to be eligible to run for office:

1. Must be a full time student during each semester in office unless fewer credits are required to graduate
2. May not be on scholastic or disciplinary probation with the university
3. Must have and maintain an overall GPA of 2.5
4. Must be a paying member of his chapter
5. Must fulfill the job specification of his office to the expectation of the Executive Council & General Assembly
6. May not hold a comparable office in his chapter concurrently during his term on the Executive Council
7. Shall be required to attend any and all Greek retreat/training programs
8. May have completed at least 30 hours from Colorado State University or any other institution of higher education by the time of elections

ELECTION INFORMATION

All Applicants shall prepare a speech that highlights their interest in the position, their previous experience, skills as they relate to the position, and their unique goals and vision for the position. The speech will be limited to three (3) minutes, with an additional two (2) minutes for questions from chapter delegates. Each person will also be allowed to have two others speak on their behalf for up to two (2) minutes each. The chapter representatives will vote by ballot.
