VIII. Old Business

- 1. IFC Recruitment Policy **Final Vote: did not pass (5 for, 13 against, 3 abstain)**
 - a. Bid delayed period to reduce the amount of pressure that a PNM could/would feel
 - b. Bid exemption
 - c. Discussion
 - i. Why change a policy that has just been changed that goes against the NIC
 - 1. One-on-ones has suggested that unexpected consequences, specifically, a pressure put on chapters to giving bids after a specific amount of events
 - 2. Hear the voices of interest groups
 - ii. Focus should be on recruitment opposed to having a bid policy
 - 1. This is up to the chapters if they choose to recruit earlier
 - iii. Why can't fraternities just have events after the ram welcome events
 - 1. Current policy and recruitment chairs have shown dislike and specifically asked to reinstate delayed bid distribution.

- iv. This a good policy because a lot of Freshman and Sophomores don't know about Greek Life and allowing more time to develop an understanding of a chapter.
- v. What was the motivation to pushing the bid process to the third week?
 - 1. It's what the previous policy was
 - 2. Stipulations on time and size of events
 - 3. Did you consider a smaller head start for interest chapters
