- 2. Proposed BYOB Tailgating additions to the Joint Risk Management Policy **Passed (Yes:16 No:4 Abstain:1)**
  - a. Tailgating at your own house if it doesn't pass?
    - i. Still register
    - ii. looks and feels like a fraternity event it is a fraternity event
  - b. Why will this be safer and better event?
    - i. Game day will look different and the influx of people on campus will pose a safety risk
    - ii. Structure of the tailgates policy imposes strict guidelines for every chapter
    - iii. Accountability of a chapter event makes a focus on safety as chapter reputation and image is on display
    - iv. This will also show that chapters are taking steps to being safe will designated areas and third party security
    - v. Providing a set of rules and correctly implementing them will demonstrate a level of risk mitigation
  - c. Can a dry chapter (Nationally) team up with a wet chapter?
    - i. Yes, that is allowed under this policy
  - d. How do we monitor that chapters will stop and start thirty minutes prior?
    - i. Mitigating it with sober monitors and any infractions that are brought up or found out will be brought up on sanctions as a chapter
  - e. Security will be subsidized by IFC by moving around funds opposed to raising dues
