 - FSL Office is open on 02/15, Mondays 8am-5pm
 - This is important for checking the mail and looking for invoices - also important for dropping of dues checks!
 - Reduced capacity due to covid guidelines
 - Spring Recruitment
 - For ALL Chapters - any time someone accepts a bid to join an organization, within 72 hours they must be added to the roster on the FSL website
 - This is really important for accountability and invoices
 - NPC MRMBA (NPC chapters only) - When a new member accepts a bid this must be completed within 72 hours (hard copy or via email)
 - Please check in with recruitment officers
 - How many women can we give bids to? (NPC Sororities)
 - You can always recruit up to chapter total
 - 190 Members
 - Example: Chapter is at 170, can give out 20 bids
 - OWS
 - If your chapter missed an OWS workshop - chapters have until February 28th to make up the OWS Kickoff. This is required! Check in with your chapter presidents.
 - Must follow up directly with the council officer in charge of the OWS pathway

- FSL - Alumni Merit Scholarships
 - At least 4, minimum \$1,000 Scholarships.
 - Must complete CSUSA by March 1st to be considered
 - Selected by Council Officers
