The Importance of PHA Delegates

A brief look at the Greek History Timeline

- 1776-The first fraternity, Phi Beta Kappa was founded at The College of William and Mary in Williamsburg, Virginia.
- 1867-The first women's fraternity, I.C. Sorosis was formed at Monmouth College in Monmouth, Illinois.
- 1874-The term sorority was coined, Gamma Phi Beta was founded as the first sorority
- 1902-National Panhellenic Conference was formed. There are now 26 NPC chapters.
- 1906 & 1908-The first African American fraternity, Alpha Phi Alpha, and the first African American sorority, Alpha Kappa Alpha were formed.
- 1909-The National Interfraternity Conference was formed. It's now known as North-American Interfraternity Conference (IFC).
- 1931-Phi Iota Alpha Latino Fraternity Inc. was founded as the first Latino fraternity
- 1987-The Fraternity Insurance Purchasing Group (FIPG) was created.
- 1980s-1990s-A rise in multiculturalism led to a rise in membership for culturally based fraternities and sororities
