 - What defines a disability?

- “A **disability** is any condition of the body or mind (impairment) that makes it more difficult for the person with the condition to do certain activities (activity limitation) and interact with the world around them (participation restrictions).”
 - Chronic health conditions and mental health issues, while not always defined as a disability, may still be debilitating and impair access to events for some women
 - Questions
 - How does our chapter take into consideration ability and accessibility when planning our chapter programming?
 - How can we make changes to increase accessibility for women currently in our chapter and PNMs?
 - Are we being respectful of privacy when discussing excuses from events for women who may have a disability, illness, or other condition?
