 - The DEI Director will be responsible for writing the position description during the next election cycle
 - o Eligibility to serve as an officer shall depend on the class of membership:
 - A. Regular Membership. Members from women's fraternities holding regular membership in the Colorado State University Panhellenic Association shall be eligible to serve as any officer.
 - B. Associate Membership. Members from women's fraternities holding associate membership in the Colorado State Panhellenic Association shall be eligible to serve as any officer except President, Vice President of Recruitment, Director of PNM Experiences, Director of Recruitment Coaches, Director of Recruitment Operations and Director of Recruitment Promotion.
 - o To be eligible for a Panhellenic Association officer position, a member must:
 - A. Hold a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher while in office and to run for office
 - a. If a candidate does not have the required GPA to run for office, they may submit a grade exception to run for office. This exception must be extenuating in circumstance and will be reviewed by the slating committee to determine the individual's eligibility.
 - a. Grades will be checked at the beginning of term and beginning of second semester of term. Officers that do not meet the GPA requirement are required to meet with the Panhellenic advisor and President to develop an academic plan for the semester.
 - 2. Have completed at least 30 credit hours at Colorado State University or any other institution of higher education prior to election
